As you can imagine, there are great needs to help this family get back on their feet. Blessings in this story is they do own the land, and someone provided them with a camper to live in, but reminder, there are 8 living in the camper and limited space.



If anyone has the desire to help financially then **checks need to be made payable to Johnny Robertson.** If cash is given, when you bring it to the church office have it noted to go to the Robertson family. **DO NOT make checks payable to the church.**

Also, if you provide any new or gently worn clothing and/or shoe, bring your donations to the church. It can be helpful for the Robertson to note on the sack which person is to be the recipient of the item(s).

Either Gary, Pastor Regina or Pastor Chris will make trips to Mt. Pine on an "as needed" basis to take clothing, food and money to the family. It is estimated that the next trip will be early next week. We are continuing to receive more generous donations, and one family has donated a car to the family. GOD IS GOOD!!!!

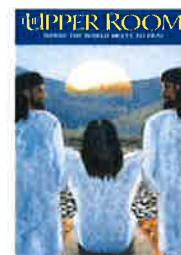
Financial donations are also appreciated.
