**I missed you last Sunday, but I joined a good number of folks in the early service from afar. I sure am grateful as always for our Regina Turner and her message, “I Am”. Regina serves as our Associate Pastor for Visitation, but as you know, she is a gifted preacher and Bible teacher. She is a blessing for VUMC and to me personally. It is good to be in ministry alongside her.**

**Also Sunday morning, I joined the livestream service for a sermon preached by a seminary classmate in Richmond, Virginia. Sarah, too, is a gifted preacher, and her message “From Seed to Spirit” was quite inspiring as I reflected upon it this week.**

**Listening in to both sermons reminded me of just how blessed we find ourselves in this journey of discipleship and faith. All of us are blessed by persons who model the gospel message for us, who follow the way of Christ, and who teach us how-to live-in faith and hope as disciples.**

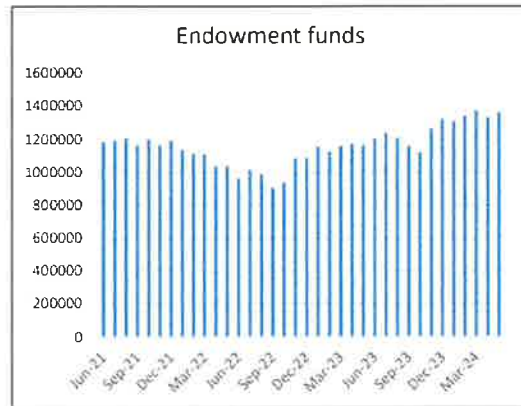
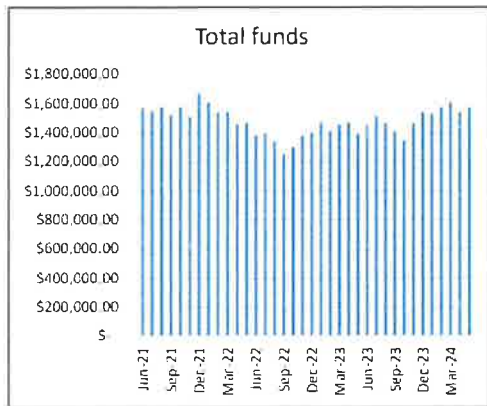
