Another part of worship is the bringing the light of Christ into the room. Have a candle available and light the candle as the acolytes light the candles in the sanctuary.

The need for a picture is to take a picture of your communion elements (notice the sample in the article) and send it to the communications email below. The picture will be part of a video which will be shown on our Facebook page for World Communion.

If you traditionally attend worship *in person* you will need to "stage" the look of experiencing Holy Communion at home, then take a picture and send to communications@villageumc.net.
