THE FOUNDATION CAME FOR A VISIT

Yesterday, October 16, we received a visit from Rev. Wayne Clark from The Methodist Foundation for Arkansas. Some of you may realize what a blessing The Foundation is for individuals and extremely for VUMC. Our Endowment Fund, and most notably the Mona Galloway Mobile Food Pantry, are part of MFA. Just a little information The Foundation began over 60 years ago, in 1963. There are over 170 churches and institutions invested, with more than 800 accounts, including individuals. Their profits/earnings are used for grants to churches and institutions for ministry in Arkansas. Some noted grants are Clergy and Laity Education (a current education opportunity being provided is full cost for the class, including the 2-night stay, for the Fall Convo at Perkins School of Theology/SMU "Faith in the Digital Age", which communications Lisa will be attending), Evangelism, Discipleship, Food Insecurity, Poverty, Charity, Environmental, etc., therefore your money is invested in socially responsible ways.
