whose reach is to engage youth who were active in the "Me Too Movement," "Black Lives Matter," and other movements during the social upheaval and demonstrations within our communities by pivoting the development and interests of these youth to the church via leadership opportunities for social engagement and congregational innovation.

As a former Mission Advocate and Global Mission Fellow, she has served in the National Council of Churches in Seoul, Korea, assisting with the reconciliation and reunification in North and South Korea via the NCC Justice and Peace Team.

Trisha, formerly from Atlanta and a PK (Pastor's Kid), graduated from Agnes Scott College, Decatur, Georgia, with a Bachelor of Arts in English Literature. She continued to follow God's call in employment by being a teacher, a tutor, and an AmeriCorps (americorps.gov) member, traveling the world in faith witnessing the power of God in His works, praise, and community.

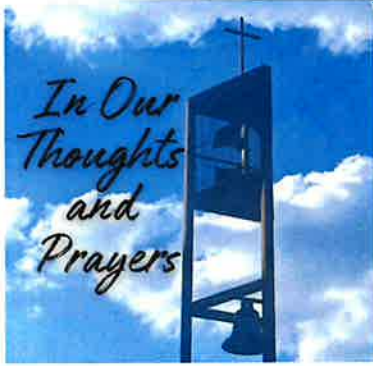
WELCOME NEW MEMBERS to VUMC





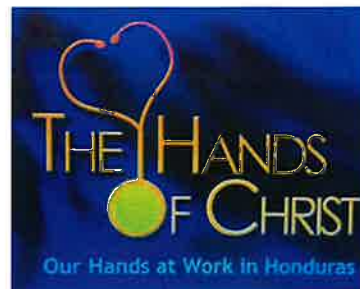
