A word from Pastor Chris

As we listen for important words this Lent, we come to a word that may feel a bit out of place for a season such as Lent. That word is glorify.

And yet, in John 12, we hear Jesus speak: "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified... Father, glorify your name." A short moment later, another voice is heard coming from heaven: "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again."

This text - John 12: 20-36 - invites us to listen for the voice of God in our Lenten journey. Our Disciple II class this week heard from Rev. Dr. Zan Holmes who challenges the church to become a listening church again.

What does this mean to you? What noise will need removed in order to listen more fully? What will you do with what you hear as God speaks?

We will explore these questions and more Sunday as I continue in the sermon series, Words for Life: Glorify!

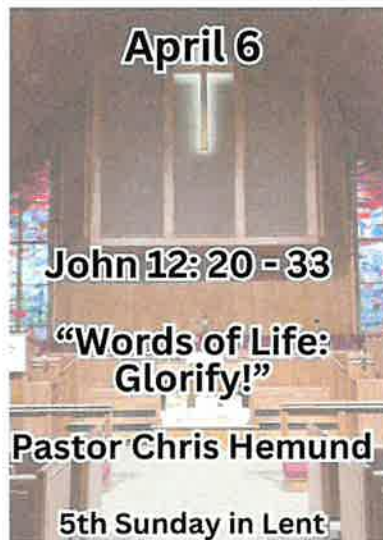

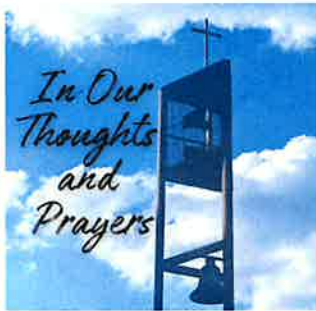


Radio Ministry
